SUPERVISOR COMMENTS

Calls for service were steady throughout the shift. At one point, an officer was taking a report of a theft that occurred at Home Depot. He was alerted by Loss Prevention Officers that a theft was in progress at TJ Maxx. Officers responded to the area and located a

vehicle occupied by one of the involved, and a female and male nearby. Upon contacting them, one male fled on foot while the female fled into a nearby store. Officers pursued the male on foot while other officers detained the other two involved. It was determined through the course of the investigation that two of the subjects were involved in thefts at Kohl's two previous times and had yet to be identified. Two of the subjects were ultimately booked into County Jail.
